The regular monthly Borough Council workshop meeting held at 110 West Arch Street, Suite 113 was called to order at 6:52pm by Borough Council President, Suzanne Touch.

Motion to make Councilmember Boyer the temporary recording secretary in lieu of Doreen O'Neil for this meeting only was made by C. Young and seconded by R. Touch. Motion approved unanimously.

Solicitor George explained the proposed purchase of the W. Race St. parcel.

Resolution to accept an Agreement in Lieu of Condemnation of the W. Race Street parcel in the amount of \$65,000, contingent on a clean title search, was made by C. Young, seconded by J. Rothenberger. Motion approved unanimously.

Motion to approve a lease agreement between the Borough and Berks County for a ten-year lease of office space located in the Community Center for Magisterial District Judge 23-3-04. Motion made by P. Merkel, seconded by R. Touch. Motion approved unanimously.

There was a discussion about the transportation of inmates by the constables to attend court hearings in the Community Center. The consensus was to have the constables avoid taking inmates near the cafeteria, gym, and public restrooms as much as possible to limit the possibility of alarming any persons using those areas.

It was agreed to identify two parks in Fleetwood Borough with numbered addresses to better assist EMS during calls. The main park on W. Main St. will be identified as 333 W. Main St. The Locust Street Park will be identified as 600 E. Locust St.

Motion to pay the bills. Motion made by J. Rothenberger, seconded by R. Touch. Motion approved unanimously.
