

Memorial Day Program Changes

To All Fleetwood Area Residents and Friends

As you are aware, major street construction is on going throughout the Borough of Fleetwood. **The *Fleetwood American Legion*, in consultation with borough leaders has made major changes to the parade portion of the program.** All other related activities will continue as before including memorial services at the Fleetwood and St. Paul's cemeteries and followed by the annual Memorial Day Program in the Fleetwood Community Park.

The parade participants will form on Laurel Street (between Main St. and Arch St.). The Memorial Day program will begin at 9:00 AM, on May 28, 2018, with a short memorial service in the Fleetwood Cemetery, after which the parade will begin by moving west on Arch Street to Franklin Street, south on Franklin Street to Main Street, west on Main Street and continue until reaching the Fleetwood Community Park. Upon reaching the park, the Color Guard and Firing Squad will continue to the St. Paul's Cemetery and take part in a short memorial service before returning to the Community Park for on-going ceremonies.

This year's speaker will be Mr. Dale Derr, Director of Berks County Veterans Affairs and our clergy representative will be Pastor Tom Lang of St. Paul's Evangelical Lutheran Church in Fleetwood.
