We are open daily from 11:00am - 7:30pm

Important Information

- "Members-Only" time 11:00am-1:00pm (daily admission guests are permitted during these times ONLY when entering with a member)
- At 1:00pm, daily admission passes will be sold (we do reserve the right to suspend daily admission ticket sales if the pool is near or at capacity)
- The "lap area/diving well" will be closed from 11:00am-12:00pm Monday through Saturday, 6:00-7:30pm on Tuesday and Thursday, and 7:00-7:30pm on Thursday during swim team season (June-July)

General Facility Rules

- Coolers are allowed, but NO alcoholic beverages and/or glass allowed on the premises.
- Please pick up your trash.
- Foul language is prohibited.
- Refrain from socializing with lifeguards while they are on duty.
- All infants and toddlers who are not potty-trained **must** wear a swim diaper while in the water. Something must be covering the swim diaper (bathing suit, onesie). Swim diapers are available for purchase at the pool office.
- Proper swimwear is required and left to the discretion of the manager.
- No smoking, vaping, or use of tobacco products within the pool area. Tobacco use is only allowed in the designated smoking area outside the pool. It is unlawful for any minor under the age of 18 to use or possess tobacco in any form within the Borough of Fleetwood, on any Borough owned property, on any public street, highway, traffic way, alley, or sidewalk.

General Pool Rules

- No running on the pool deck.
- Diving is only allowed in the diving well. Diving is prohibited anywhere else.
- While playing basketball: no hanging on the rim, no fighting over the ball, and no over the shoulders.
- Scuba masks cannot be worn during the following: going off the diving board or in the diving well area.
- Chicken fights (sitting or standing on someone else's shoulders), dunking, or jumping on top of someone else is prohibited.
- Use of pool toys including water guns, balls, and sporting activities are allowed at the discretion of the manager. Any ball must be soft – no tennis balls or hard footballs, the pool basketball is permitted for use with the basketball net
- Do not play on the ramp or walk on the ledge of the ramp.

Diving Well Rules

- Anyone under the age of 14 must take the **swim test** to be admitted into the diving well area.

Swim Test

1. Swimmers who wish to take the swim test must report to the office and request to take the test.
 2. Under the supervision of a lifeguard, the swimmer will be asked to swim 1 complete lap from the deep end to the shallow end. The swimmer must swim the entire length on the front (no back) and is not allowed to stop, grab the wall, or touch the bottom during the test. If the swimmer is able to accomplish this task, the swimmer will be given a wrist band that will need to be worn to be allowed to enter the diving well area. If the swimmer does not pass the test, the swimmer may try to re-take the test at another time. If the swimmer is on the swim team and is able to swim the required length in the manner described above, the swimmer will be logged in the book for the season.
 3. The swimmer's name will be recorded in the Swim Test Log. Once a swimmer passes the test, he/she will not need to re-take the test each day. Each day, the swimmer will need to report to the office and will be able to receive a new wrist band.
 4. We will have monthly checks of swimmers. A sign will be posted to alert swimmers when a new swim test will need to be taken.
- No flips off of the diving board.
 - No flotation devices allowed in the diving well.
 - Jumping/swimming between the 10-12 ft. area is left to the discretion of the lifeguard on duty.
 - Scuba masks and/or goggles cannot be worn while using the diving board.
 - Scuba masks cannot be worn while swimming in the diving area.

Disciplinary Action

When a patron breaks a rule, the following disciplinary actions will be taken:

1. First offense: a warning will be issued.
2. Second offense: the offender will be benched for a period of time at the discretion of the lifeguard.
3. Third offense: the offender will be given a suspension from the pool. Time limit will be at the discretion of the manager.

***Serious offenses may warrant immediate suspension/expulsion from the pool. Time limit will be at the discretion of the manager.

Bad Weather

Closings and delayed openings for bad weather or no attendance will be left to the discretion of the manager. All closings and delayed openings will be posted on the "Friends of Fleetwood Pool" Facebook page. If it storms within 3 hours of your arrival, you will receive a rain check to come back and visit us another day.

Personal Items

Please limit the personal items that you bring to the pool. Please bring only the necessary items needed for swimming. The Borough of Fleetwood is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Age Limit

Children 8 years and under will not be permitted in the pool area unsupervised. Parents must supervise their children while in the water.
