ORDINANCE NO. 659

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FLEETWOOD, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 277 ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", OF THE BOROUGH CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF FLEETWOOD, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, SECTION 277-3 ENTITLED "PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES", ARTICLE I ENTITLED "GENERAL REGULATIONS; PARKING", TO PROHIBIT PARKING AT ALL TIMES ALONG THE NORTH SIDE OF WEST ELM STREET BETWEEN SOUTH RICHMOND STREET AND SOUTH CHESTNUT STREET AND ALONG THE SOUTH SIDE OF WEST ELM STREET FROM SOUTH RICHMOND STREET EXTENDING FORTY-FIVE FEET (45') SOUTHWEST, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Fleetwood, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 277-3 entitled "Parking Prohibited at All Times", Article I entitled "General Regulations; Parking", of Chapter 277 entitled "Vehicles and Traffic", of the Borough Code of the Borough of Fleetwood, Berks County, Pennsylvania (the "Fleetwood Borough Code") is hereby amended and supplemented to add that parking shall be prohibited at all times along the North side of West Elm Street between South Richmond Street and South Chestnut Street and along the South side of West Elm Street from South Richmond Street extending forty-five feet (45') Southwest, as follows:

Name of Street	Side	Location
West Elm Street	North	Between South Richmond Street and South Chestnut Street
West Elm Street	South	From South Richmond Street extending forty-five feet (45') Southwest

SECTION 2. Appropriate official signs shall be erected at convenient locations along West Elm Street where parking is prohibited.

SECTION 3. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, part or provision hereof shall be held to be illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the court shall not affect the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, parts or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Borough that such Ordinance would have been enacted if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part or provision had not been included herein.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of this Borough which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. The Borough Code of the Borough of Fleetwood, Berks County, Pennsylvania, as amended, shall be and remain unchanged and in full force and effect except as amended, supplemented or modified by this Ordinance. This Ordinance shall become a part of the Borough Code upon adoption.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date permitted by law following the date of its enactment.
